Modest Morató Ojer (Barcelona 1909-1993), circa 1960s. Rare bright enameled copper melange plaque by Morató depicting the Crucifixion. Inspired by 12th and 13th-century enameled copper plaques from the Romanesque workshops of Limoges. Exceptional technique and craftsmanship. The last image is from the Metropolitan Museum of Art (Met) website, which includes in its collection a champlevé enameled copper plaque from the first quarter of the 13th century. This plaque inspired the jeweler and artist Ojer. Dimensions: overall 26.5 x 26.5 x 3.5 cm / plaque 18.5 x 18 cm
