Large bronze of Hermes fastening his sandals. Hermes, or Mercury, appears in this beautiful bronze as a young man fastening his sandals to a rock. This fine neoclassical bronze is of very high quality, with a golden patina that is slightly oxidized. The god has a superb face and rests on a lightly worked granite block. there is a small loss of bronze at the point where his garment is tied. Perhaps he was carrying a quiver... As it dates from the first half of the 19th century, it is cast in several parts, and one of the arms is slightly loose. A very beautiful bronze of very high quality with a superb neoclassical aesthetic, probably a souvenir from the Grand Tour. Dimensions: 33 cm high.
