Description

Oil on panel - Bretons with a bowl of cider. This oil painting on panel depicts a Breton genre scene: three men in traditional costume are gathered around a table, sharing a convivial moment over bowls of cider. The scene, typical of rural Breton life, exudes a warm and authentic atmosphere. The composition is balanced, the poses natural, and the faces expressive. The palette, dominated by muted tones of blues, browns, and grays, is enhanced by a soft light that highlights the figures and reinforces the intimate character of the work. The brushwork is supple and controlled, in keeping with the tradition of figurative painting from the late 19th or early 20th century, reflecting the taste of regionalist painters. Technique: Oil on panel. Subject: Breton genre scene, Bretons with a bowl of cider.
