Description

This charming scene with a young assistant was painted in 1873 by Hermann Pistor (1832 Neustrelitz - after 1866 Berlin), a listed German genre and portrait painter. The artist studied at the Dresden Academy (1850-1851) and in Frankfurt am Main under Jak. Becker. He settled in Berlin in 1866. The Frankfurt am Main city collection includes another genre painting by this artist.
