Magnificent Limoges porcelain cachepot, entirely hand-painted by Desgropes. The famous Limoges roses contributed to the renown of the world capital of the ceramic arts. Desgropes was a painter active in the 1920s and 30s who succeeded in reproducing nature on porcelain. Here, the antique roses are true to life, with fullness and almost perfect proportions. This cachepot has its original base. The white porcelain dates from the late 19th century, manufactured by Tressmanes and Vogt, and the decoration by Desgropes dates from the 1920s-1930s.
