"Diana is one of the most important figures in the Greco-Roman pantheon. Goddess of the hunt, war, and the night, she lives in the woods surrounded by nymphs and rejects the advances of her many suitors. The representation of Diana has been recurrent in art since antiquity, and many high-ranking ladies identified with this goddess. From the 16th century onward,
