Set of service cutlery in its blue silk interior with the name of "Roger Chabert à Beziers" composed of 10 pieces in a square burgundy leather box. The handle of each piece in silver filled monogrammed at the center, is finely crafted with a rich decor of vaguelettes rocaille. The set consists of: A meat service (knife and fork) A fish service with a decor of foliage (shovel and fork) A salad service in ivory (spoon and fork) A small-oven service (a spoon, a fork and a spatula) A spoon, to be sprinkled. Silversmith : Jean Francois Veyrat and his son Adolphe. Their hallmark was create in 1840 and canceled in 1849. Their workshop was 20 rue de Malte (Paris).
