Directoire or Restoration period, length: 23 cm. The second, with its key-head ring and turned stem, features an openwork fleur-de-lis on its scoop. Louis XVI period, 14.5 cm. The third, an even smaller smoker's shovel, is very finely crafted. 19th century, 17 cm.
