Description

I present here a beautiful, elegant, and functional 18th-century piece of furniture entirely inlaid with rosewood, lemonwood, palisander, and satinwood stringing. Its generously shaped front features two upper drawers and two separate doors. The top, like the front, is meticulously inlaid with lemonwood stringing framing a rosewood center, edged on the exterior with satinwood and dark palisander. The drawer pulls and knobs are bronze. The cabriole legs are sturdy and understated, and the interior details, like the back panels, are carefully crafted. This decorative and well-made piece, known as a "basin" or "lower cabinet" buffet, is pure Louis XV style and exceptionally well executed. Its curved front and arched doors play with the light and beautifully break up the straight lines. The
