Each armchair features a generously padded, straight back with a mahogany band carved in the center with a floral and scroll motif within a lozenge shape. High, cuffed armrests rest on straight front legs, also carved in relief. The saber-shaped rear legs are turned outwards for added stability. The slightly curved seat rail is decorated with a rectangular carving of flowers and scrolls. The restored frame is in perfect condition; however, the studded velvet upholstery and the seat with its cushion are original. Period: Early 19th century.
