Description

This work, entitled "The Fiancée and Her Friends," depicts three women in formal attire. It is countersigned. Note that the frame was likely added later. Jean-Denis Malclès (1912-2002) was a French painter, poster artist, and set designer. He is notably responsible for creating the costumes for the Frères Jacques and several film and theater posters, including that of Jean Cocteau's *Beauty and the Beast*. From 1948 to 1981, he designed the sets and costumes for most of Jean Anouilh's plays, establishing a true symbiosis with the author. He also works for the Renaud-Barrault Company. Regarding the condition, there are stains, foxing, scratches, and scuffs on the frame; however, the work is in generally acceptable condition. Please examine the photos carefully.
