An elegant Chinese smoking set made of copper alloy, richly decorated with dragons and chimeras in relief. This set comprises four matching pieces, demonstrating refined decorative craftsmanship. The style and technique date this object to the late Qing dynasty (1644-1911), with probable use during the Republic of China period (1912-1949). The symbolism of the dragons evokes power and prosperity. A heavy and decorative set (approx. 1740 g), representative of luxury objects intended for the Chinese elite of the early 20th century.
