Dimensions Height 28cm Width 18cm Depth 12cm \*\* Joseph Hugues FABISCH (1812-1886) Fabisch is an official sculptor and statuary of the diocese of Lyon. his achievements between 1852 and 1864, we can cite: - 1852 : Notre Dame de Fourvière in Lyon - 1852 : altar of the apse of Saint Benedict, basilica of Saint-Martin d'Ainay in Lyon 2nd arr. - 1855 : Virgin and Child, of the Maison Blanchon at the corner of Quais Fulchiron and Place Benoît Crépu, Lyon 5th arr.
