They feature a comfortable seat with a cushion upholstered in gold-and-silver fabric with floral decorations.

This is a tasteful and elegant set of chairs, capable of adding a touch of class to any room. Made in Lucca (Tuscany, Italy), from the Empire period, circa early 19th century.
