Pair of covered silver-plated sauce boats decorated with scrolls, foliage, and rocaille motifs. Mid-19th century. England - Circa 1890-1900. Gross weight 1404 g. Dimensions (H x W x D): 20 x 26 x 12 cm. This type of piece was very popular during the Victorian and Edwardian periods. They were often used in pairs to serve two different sauces (hot or cold, meat or fish). They could be made of solid silver or, like ours, of silver-plated metal.
