Being made in the Regency period, the pair features a most wonderful design of a gadrooned border, with the rest presenting an understated yet splendid mirror finish.Particularly noteworthy and desirable for the discerning collector is the usage of solid silver even on the base which distinguishes this pair from counterpart coasters that usually have a wooden base. Such opulence in combination with its mirror finish allows for the light to reflect and 'bounce' off each section, further elevating the splendour and ambience of whichever setting they may be used in. Underneath, a wooden base and felt lining are present in order to prevent scratches on the surface of the table. Undoubtedly
