The crown is embellished with 9 points & pearls at the top, followed by a row of rubies, emeralds and diamonds. In between each row lies a fabulous array of fine old rose-cut diamonds, graduating in size for each section. A 9-pointed crown/coronet is typically associated with a count/countess in French heraldry. The silver front allows for the diamonds to sparkle even more and presents a
