The wrought iron base, with its dynamic design and partially gilt finish, is topped with a warm-toned travertine top. The combination of the stone and the gilt metal creates an elegant and luminous piece, perfect between two armchairs or as an end table. Gilbert Poillerat (1902-1988) was one of the great French masters of wrought iron, a leading figure of late Art Deco and the 1940s and 50s. Trained at the École Boulle, he created railings, lighting fixtures, and furniture for private residences and ocean liners, employing a vocabulary of scrolls, foliage, and stars.
