Description

Large painting depicting a military scene featuring artillerymen of the French colonial army operating the famous 80mm cannon. One of the gunners has just been hit and collapses in the arms of his superior. Severed heads belonging to "the enemy" can be seen hanging from a tree in the upper left corner of the canvas. This scene likely takes place during the colonization of Cochinchina (present-day South Vietnam) or Tonkin (present-day North Vietnam). This painting would benefit from cleaning; yellowish stains are visible. This oil on canvas is signed in the lower right corner by Joseph Peyraud and dated 1904. It is sold unframed. Dimensions: 60 cm x 90 cm
