This emblematic pattern graced the grand French flatware sets of the 20th century. This particular spoon is in pristine, unused condition. The silver plating is intact, with no wear. Produced in the 1980s. Made in France. Length: 24 cm. This piece is designed for serving ice cream and frozen desserts. Ideal for completing a Marly flatware set, replacing a missing piece, or creating a cohesive and high-end serving ensemble.
