A silver-plated fish serving fork by Christofle, Marly pattern, reference no. 80. The Marly pattern is one of Christofle's most iconic designs. Inspired by the Louis XV style and the Rococo vocabulary of the 18th century, it is distinguished by its rich chasing of shells, foliage, and asymmetrical scrolls. This pattern is a cornerstone of grand French flatware sets of the 20th century. This example is in pristine condition, never used, and kept in its original Christofle box. The silver plating is intact, without wear or scratches. Produced in the 1980s. Made in France. Length: 21.5 cm. This piece, designed for serving fish, is ideal for completing a Marly flatware set, replacing a missing piece, or enriching a cohesive and elegant service.
