Description

The upper section of this beautiful cabinet opens with two doors adorned with exquisite bone marquetry, revealing a mahogany and mirrored interior fitted with drawers and a shelf. Each door is divided into three panels. The central panel, dominated by a winged sphinx on a slender base, is set within a foliate border with scrolls. The two smaller panels depict bouquets and ears of wheat. The upper rail is decorated with a frieze, featuring a woman's face at its center, surrounded by seahorses and squirrels, within a foliate setting. The sides are decorated with geometric fillet motifs. The lower section, forming a writing desk, opens to reveal a drawer with snail motifs, again within a foliate border. The interior, with its compartments, is also made of mahogany. It rests on four tapered and fluted legs, joined by an 'H'
