Description

Tapestry (wall art) by Pierre Chevalley for Suzy Langlois, Paris, 1970s. Published in Paris by Suzy Langlois, a publisher known for her collaborations with artists and art publishers (notably tapestries after Dalí, produced in France), a guarantee of meticulous craftsmanship. Pierre Chevalley (Switzerland) creates abstract works imbued with calligraphy and black/white contrasts; he participated in the Lausanne Tapestry Biennials (1967, 1969), anchoring his work in the textile art of his time. The piece presents a structured abstract composition--planes, signs, and rhythms--with an elegant graphic rendering, easily integrated into a contemporary or mid-century interior. A beautiful piece of 1970s wall art, combining the signature of an artist and a renowned publisher. Discover
