Description

Tony Cardella (1898-1976), a French painter, remained particularly faithful to his Corsican roots and the South of France, in the tradition of the Provençal school painters. After studying at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, he developed a unique style associated with Impressionist painting. His works often depict landscapes, seascapes, and sunlit scenes of daily life, revealing every detail through a richness of texture, color, and luminous intensity. Attached to the small port of Saint-Tropez, he quickly immortalized the place and contributed to its international renown. This painting depicts fishing boats on the sand of La Ponche beach in Saint-Tropez, Var, France. The colors in this painting are warm and harmonious, reminiscent of certain 19th-century Orientalist paintings from

the Mediterranean region. As is often the case in Cardella's paintings, one can still see the small port accommodating fishing boats and the activity inherent to this place.
