Description

A patinated bronze personal seal depicting a finely modeled elephant's head. The reverse is decorated with a stylized vegetal motif, executed with delicacy, characteristic of late 19th-century decorative taste. The elegantly curved shaft features a continuous engraved design, while the openwork top testifies to meticulous casting and chasing. The circular matrix is engraved with a calligraphic monogram dominated by the letter M, indicating personal use. In its style and quality of execution, this seal belongs to the aesthetics of the Belle Époque, with marked affinities to Central European and Viennese production (Jugendstil), without formal attribution.
