Hallmark of Jean I ISENHEIM, received as a master around 1760. Rosette countermark on the inner base. STRASBOURG, Last third of the 18th century. In very good condition. The recent archival discovery of a Jean II compels us to clarify the period of activity of Jean I, who was mentioned as having received as a master around 1784. It should be noted here that at that time Alsace was not part of the Kingdom of France,
