Description

This solid silver set comprises an egg cup holder with a rotating tray. It is accompanied by four footed egg cups and their matching spoons, one of which features a unique design. The tray incorporates discreet slots to elegantly hold the egg spoons. The egg cups rest on a conical base, providing stability and ensuring they remain in place as the tray rotates. They are adorned with a blank cartouche surrounded by birds. The design was formerly engraved. The fourth spoon is solid silver, hallmarked with the Minerva mark (950/1000). It has a plain decoration with a small palmette frieze on the bowl. Hallmarks: Minerva, 1st standard 950/1000. Silversmith: EC with a rabbit for Ernest Compère in Paris. 19th-century work, from 1868 to 1888. A rare and charming object in
