The poses are graceful, the faces delicately rendered, and each figure is highlighted with fine gold, accentuating the richness and depth of the decoration. The main scenes are framed by broad floral and vegetal friezes, blending foliage, stylized flowers, and ornamental motifs, executed in a subtle polychrome palette dominated by cream, blue, green, red, and gold tones.
