This Art Deco sideboard, dating from the 1930s, is crafted from walnut veneer with a rich, warm grain. Its architectural lines are typical of the period, resulting in a piece that is both understated, balanced, and decidedly modern. The front is organized around a central, built-in glass-fronted cabinet with a glass shelf, ideal for displaying decorative objects or collectibles. This cabinet is framed by two highly sculpted uprights adorned with stylized plant motifs, lending the piece a sculptural presence while maintaining the inherent elegance of Art Deco. On either side, the sideboard opens with two wide, solid doors with curved panels, emphasizing the pursuit of volume and fluidity characteristic of this era. The original metal handles, with their clean and dynamic design, contribute fully to the overall Art Deco
