The overall three-dimensional form and shape are sensationnally crafted with beautiful curves and captivating features no matter the angle. True to Rococo philosophy & design, these shells feature a fluid and ornate design with scalloped edges and scrolled/flaired terminals as if to invite the viewer to take a look at it from all sides.
