Veneto, early 19th century - Empire period
Elegant Venetian side table, dating to the early 19th century, during the Empire period, crafted with remarkable skill in cherry wood, with maple stringing and internal elements. The rectangular top features a central ink decoration depicting two putti, set within a landscape. Although partially softened and worn over time, the decoration remains clearly legible and retains considerable charm. Especially refined are the ink decorations applied to the four corners, where Empire-style urns appear, better preserved than the top due to reduced wear. These details give the table strong stylistic character and reinforce its chronological attribution. The structure is remarkably slender and elegant: the legs, extremely thin and technically demanding, begin

with a section of approximately 4 cm and taper progressively to about 1.5 cm at the lower end. This feature reflects a high level of cabinetmaking expertise, achievable only through an in-depth understanding of the wood and its natural tensions. The structure is completed by a shaped lower shelf, contributing to both stability and visual balance. The condition is good, with wear and signs of age consistent with its period, and a warm, authentic patina that enhances the quality of the woods employed.
