Description

Important stoneware bas-relief by artist Odile Devauchelle, a French artist born in 1943 who worked in her pottery studio in Saint Savin sur Gartempe for many years. Her pottery was fired in a traditional wood-fired kiln. Her creations generally focused on shaped pieces such as vases and lamp bases. Very few bas-reliefs of this type exist, and this is a rare, large-format work by the artist, making it a major piece in her oeuvre. Works by the artist are regularly presented by a major Parisian French gallery at Design Miami/Basel, where they are very successful alongside pieces by Ramié, Picault, Pouchain, Madoura, and others. This bas-relief is composed of 22 pottery elements sculpted before firing and assembled on a wooden panel. Note the richness of the decoration, which at its center depicts a
