### Description

After Joan Miró - Grand Palais, Paris (1974) American-made hooked rug Based on the design from the poster for the Joan Miró exhibition at the Grand Palais, Paris, 1974. Wool rug made using the hooked rug technique, a traditional North American craft involving pulling strands of wool through a backing to create the design. This method gives the work a dense texture and characteristic relief, while respecting the graphic and chromatic vigor of the original motif. This rug faithfully reproduces the iconic composition created by Joan Miró for the poster of his exhibition at the Grand Palais in Paris in 1974. The black biomorphic forms, punctuated with vibrant primary colors, convey the artist's poetic and symbolic universe, poised between abstraction and dreamlike imagery.
