Transition Work, Attributed to André-Louis Gilbert  
Small chiffonier drum table decorated with lake and antique landscapes in stained wood framed with amaranth. It opens with a ring door revealing a small turquin blue marble slab. It rests on three arched legs ending in bronze sabots. The feet are connected by a crotch shelf surrounded by a gilded bronze ingot mold with landscape decoration. The top in gilded morocco leather and framed in rosewood is surrounded by a gilded bronze gallery. André - Louis GILBERT, received master on July 20, 1774  
Renowned cabinetmaker, received master's degree on July 20, 1774, André Louis Gilbert settled in 1785 in Faubourg Saint-Antoine. He produced very important productions of various styles (Louis XV, Transition and Louis XVI) All his creations are
