

Goldscheider founded the Goldscheidersche
Porzellan-Manufactur und Majolica-Fabrik in
Vienna in 1885. He employed some of the finest
sculptors and designers, and Goldscheider
figurines were primarily fashioned in alabaster,
faience, terracotta, or bronze. His work was of its
time, generally showing Orientalist, Art Deco,
Historicist, and Art Nouveau influences. Also

Goldscheider's historical and theatrical ceramics included subjects such as Joan of Arc and Othello. When Goldscheider and his family left Vienna and settled in the United Kingdom and the United States. When they obtained a patent for bronze-glazing statues made of other materials, the entrepreneur opened a Parisian branch of his company because Goldscheider's bronze figurines were popular there.
