In the 17th century, candlesticks were widely used in churches, chapels, and private oratories, as well as in aristocratic homes, particularly for illuminating fireplaces and tables on special occasions. They played a crucial role in the overall lighting design. Through their understated elegance, the quality of the bronze, and the balance of their proportions, these candlesticks perfectly exemplify the aesthetics of the 17th century.
