Description

A silver potbellied teapot with a melon-shaped body, resting on an outline pedestral. The handle and the top are made of ivory. At its center is a coat of arms: "Azure, a gold rowel in chief and a silver crescent in base." under the count's coronet. This coat of arms is inserted in a belt on which the motto is inscribed "Vel arte vel marte" (either by art or by force). This belt wears a knight's helmet decorated with 5 feathers and has 7 grilles attesting to her title of Count. Silversmith: François Désiré Froment Meurice (registration in 1833). Inscribed under the base in full: Maison Meurice Froment and silversmith's mark. Weight: 996 g. Height: 17 cm.
