Radiator mascot of the famous Rolls-Royce automobile brand, known as the "Spirit of Ecstasy" or "Flying Lady," this model is made of pewter (92%, see photos). The statue rests on a square marble base. This mascot, emblematic of the British brand, was created in 1911 by Charles Sykes; the woman who inspired him was the model Eleanor Thornton (1880-1915).
