This magnificent covered vase with its carved wooden base is a testament to Chinese craftsmanship from the first half of the 20th century (Republican period, circa 1920-1950). Carved from nephrite jade in a delicate celadon green hue, the piece is distinguished by its translucency and silky polish. The body of the vase is adorned with an intricate naturalistic design, carved in high relief and openwork. It features blooming chrysanthemum flowers, symbols of longevity and nobility in Eastern culture, whose petals curl with great finesse around the body. The removable lid extends this floral harmony, creating perfect visual unity. Resting on a finely openwork base of precious wood, this decorative piece combines the hardness of the stone with the lightness of the
