Description

A set of nine large solid silver coins (poids total 250 grammes) comprising five 50-franc coins (1974, 1977, 1978, 1978, 1978) and four 10-franc coins (1965, 1970, 1970, 1970). The set features a design depicting Hercules wearing the skin of the Nemean lion, accompanied by allegorical figures representing Liberty and Equality, thus symbolizing republican values. This bas-relief is signed DUPRÉ in homage to the renowned sculptor Augustin Dupré (1748-1833), engraver general of the French mint during the French Revolution and Empire. The reverse displays the denomination surrounded by laurel and oak branches, symbols of victory and strength. These coins remain a treasure for collectors, celebrating both the art and history of France.
