They majestically feature two chased bronze bobeche with elongated foliage that flows into the undulating movement. A rare and unique decorative element in the Neoclassical style, with caryatid heads supporting the candle holders. Demonstrative and ornamental, light and refined, these two lovely sconces from the era of Napoleon's conquests possess a true decorative appeal, as they are plated with bright gold and are in good condition.
