A superb pair of Transition-style mahogany and mahogany veneer side tables, with inset white marble tops. The tabletops are fitted with two silver-plated metal coolers, and the apron opens with a drawer. The tables rest on four cabriole legs joined by two stretchers, terminating in casters. Exquisitely crafted, reminiscent of the work of Canabas (Joseph Gegenbach, known as Canabas, 1715-1797). The Louvre Museum holds a similar pair in its collections, as does the Nissim de Camondo Museum (illustrated in "Musée Nissim de Camondo," 1973, no. 271, p. 65). In very good condition. Casters added later.
