This set of four Windsor chairs in beechwood, made in England in the early 20th century, embodies the rustic elegance and craftsmanship of traditional British furniture. Each chair features a rounded back, composed of slender turned spindles, carefully inserted into the seat. This turning technique lends the chairs a visual lightness while ensuring good back support. The seat, carved from a single piece of wood, is slightly concave for optimal comfort. The legs are distinguished by their turned baluster shape, with outward-sloping legs reinforced by a turned stretcher. This structure ensures excellent stability while highlighting the decorative character of the chairs. The natural patina of the beechwood, with its warm, golden tones, adds to the authentic charm of these pieces. These chairs, both sturdy
