A rare Charles X vase in fine blown and engraved crystal on a silver foot with a lacquered ebony base and ivory tripod feet. This refined vase from the early 19th century is French, and proudly resting on its base, it exemplifies generosity: "The Cornucopia," a beautiful symbol for this lovely and refined curiosity in good condition. Its body is adorned with elegant motifs of crenellated friezes, scrolls, and friezes featuring the Occitan cross within round, beaded cartouches. The neck is scalloped. A graceful line of great refinement characterizes this exceptional piece, skillfully blown with a subtle and elegant decoration. This curiosity from the very beginning of the 19th century, with its meticulous craftsmanship and beautifully stylized lines, is a perfect centerpiece for a simple table setting or for creating a small,
