Description

Iranian rug from the Fars region (southwest Iran), wool, cotton warp and weft, circa 1950. Very good condition. Great care was taken in the making of this Kashkuli. A central beige and blue medallion, rich in motifs (bouquets of flowers, cypress trees), stands out against a red background. On either side, two polychrome columns, surmounted by horses' heads, reference the ancient sculptures and bas-reliefs of Persepolis. A 'Herati' border frames the field of the rug. The Gashghai confederation comprised various tribes. Some examples: the Bozorg Kashkuli (the great ones), the Kuchek Kashkuli (the lesser ones), the Shishboluki (six districts), the Amaleh or Yalameh (workers, servants of the Khan).
