It is encircled by two sets of three bands. Control mark: crowned C / 1691 / IONVIL. Mark of Pierre ORY, received as a master around 1674: large fleur-de-lis / PO. Height: 19 cm. Low gauge: 0.355 liters. Level gauge: 0.388 liters. JOINVILLE, Circa 1700. This mark, previously encountered, was not identified. Recent archival research has allowed it to be attributed to this master, born in 1649 and received as a master around 1674. Extremely rare in provenance and size, in very good condition and very well hallmarked. Second baluster-shaped example of this center found in nearly fifty years... A small
