This collection of two spoons comes from the island of Timor, in the Lesser Sunda Islands archipelago, Indonesia, and can be dated to the late 19th century. They are carved from coconut shells, a material commonly used in local crafts for its strength and availability. The handles are finely engraved around their edges with elegant geometric designs. These spoons illustrate both traditional Timorese eating practices and the functional aesthetic characteristic of the region's cultures.
