Description

A charming rectangular enamelled copper box, dating from the 18th century, with polychrome painted decoration. The domed lid is adorned with a pastoral scene depicting a couple in a rural landscape, rendered in a delicate palette of greens, yellows, and blues, characteristic of 18th-century European production. The sides are decorated with finely executed polychrome floral garlands, while the base and interior feature white enamel. The box is mounted in a gilt copper frame with its original hinge. The piece demonstrates high-quality craftsmanship, typical of small decorative boxes from the second half of the 18th century. Good overall condition for its age. Note: - slight wear and micro-cracks to the enamel, a chip in one corner (see photo) - minor traces of oxidation and use, but no major losses.
