Description

The two-part buffet shown is a magnificent example of early 20th-century craftsmanship. Made in 1920, this mahogany piece, with rosewood, lemonwood, and dark wood inlays, is a testament to the elegance and refinement of the era. The upper section opens with two glass doors with convex panes, secured by an original lock. It is supported by two turned uprights, adding a touch of sophistication. Below, a mirror highlights the lower section, which opens with three drawers and two doors, each with inlaid marquetry panels and a shelf. The brass locks and drop rings with chased plates are details that reflect the luxury of the period. The whole rests on square wooden legs, a design choice that ensures its stability and complements its classic appearance. This base is joined by a stretcher
