




19th Century Japanese Print

Description

Japanese Print Probably from the late 19th or early 20th century Laid paper. Artist and scene to be identified. Signed in the plate on the right. Dimensions: 32 x 24.5 cm. Superb maritime subject with a lovely treatment of the sea in bokashi (??), a light mist or clouds visible in the sky revealing a subtly embossed sun, leaving its imprint on the back of the paper. The birds are also rendered with great delicacy, and the whole is in a relatively unexpected format, close to the oban format : framed in black within an oval. In good condition, it should be noted that there is a central crease (common for prints of this period) as well as a wormhole in the center near the crease and the sea horizon. This print is technically very beautiful and will certainly delight whoever can attribute it.
